

HOMOPHONE CHECKER

ALLOWED

to permit



A car is **allowed** to go on green.

ALOUD

not in a whisper



I laughed **aloud** at the funny joke.

licence, license

Joe need to contact the DVLA to **license** his car.



License, the verb, is the granting of permission to do or have something.

passed

verb → base word = pass

Hint: Does the sentence make sense if you exchange for another verb?

past

noun, adjective, adverb, preposition

Hint: Does the sentence make sense if you exchange for pass or passes?



PEACE

no violence or tension

We need peace. Not war.



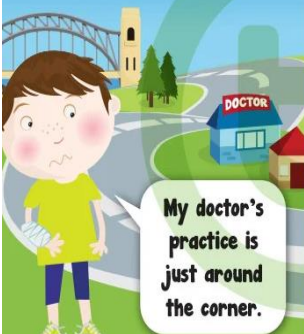
PIECE
