Too - adverb

1. In addition; also: Can Alice come too?
2. More than enough; excessively: No, she complains too much!
3. Very; extremely: Aww, she's not too annoying.
4. So: She is too!



To - preposition

1. In the direction of; toward:
We took the road that goes to town.
The alien was waving to me!
2. As far as:
The water was clear all the way to the bottom.



To - preposition

3. Indicating something received or owned:
The towel belongs to her.
4. In connection with:
She is kind to her brother.
5. Used with; intended for:
This is the key to the house.



To - adverb

1. Into a closed position
She pulled the door to.
1. Into an awake state:
The man slowly came to.



Two - noun

1. Referring to the number two:
Two birds were sitting on the fence.
