## Year 4 Homework Challenge Autumn Term 2



Topic: Saxons

Challenge 1: Write a diary entry for the day in the life of a family member in an Saxon family. You could be the father, mother, son or daughter. Write about the house they live, the jobs they and their family do and the clothes they wore?

Challenge 2: Pick one ancient Saxon King. Create a biographical text for your chosen figure. This can be presented in words / words and pictures/ any other way you see fit.

Challenge 3: Write a report to compare and contrast the lives of the Saxon children and children who live in 2022.

Challenge 4: Design and make your own Saxon shield.

Challenge 5: The Anglo-Saxons wrote using an alphabet that consisted of symbols called runes. Write your own secret message using the runic alphabet. Now see what else you can find out about Anglo-Saxon runes and write down 5 facts.
