If you win, you will be contacted to collect your prize from the school office. The name of the winner will be published on the school's website.

The prize money will be 50% of the membership fee taken that month. The remaining 50% goes to the school to help fund equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils. The more people who join, the bigger the prize. It is open to staff, parents / carers and grandparents!

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100 CLUB RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the PTA bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

RULES

1. For a cost of £1 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100 or higher depending on participation.
2. A draw will be made every month with one prize.
3. The prizes will total 50% of the annual income.
4. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of St Andrews School. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
5. Members may have more than one number.
6. Payments must be made in full by cash.
7. The draw shall be made by the Head Teacher in the last celebration assembly each month.
8. The winning number will be notified and asked to sign a receipt for any winnings.
9. The name and number for each month's winner will be posted on the school website.
10. Members joining after the start of the normal 100 Club membership year will be charged a pro rata amount for the rest of the year and entered in the next available draw following payment.
11. Registers will be kept recording the name and contact number of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
12. The 100 Club accounts will be available for inspection on request to the Chairperson of SASA on reasonable notice.
13. The 100 Club will be run by SASA. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
14. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into SASA funds after six months.
15. The SASA is registered with Sedgemoor Council to run lotteries, in accordance with the Gambling Act 2005, 1039631.

Notification regarding the processing of any personal data supplied on this form
