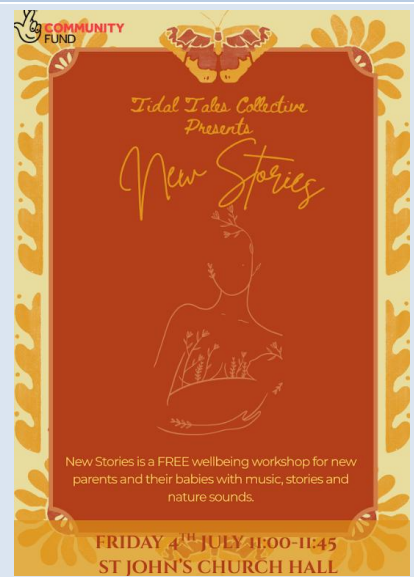

<p><b>Class Move up day</b></p>	<p>We had a wonderfully positive Move-Up Day on Wednesday. It was a joy to see the children meeting their new teachers and exploring their new classrooms with such enthusiasm and confidence. The atmosphere across the school was warm and welcoming, and it was especially lovely to greet the new intake of Year 3 children as they joined us for the first time. <p><b>Year 6 Transition</b></p>	<p>Our Year 6 children also had a fantastic few days at TKASA as part of their transition to secondary school. We've already heard some very positive and heart-warming feedback from the staff there about how well our children represented St Andrew's—confident, kind, and ready for the next stage in their journey. We're so proud of them!</p>
<p><b>VACANCY - Caretaker / Hall Lettings Manager - St Andrew's Church Hall</b></p>	<p>We are seeking a caretaker and lettings manager following retirement of the previous long term incumbent. These are part time roles with flexible working hours. Roles could be undertaken jointly by 1 person or by 2 different people. St Andrew's Church Hall is a well-used and valued community resource for clubs and groups. As well as a main hall, it has a well equipped and large kitchen area, toilet facilities and small storage areas.</p> <p>Training – Both roles will require appropriate safeguarding training as required by the Diocese of Bath and Wells. This can be accessed online or given face to face by a member of the church. It will be at no cost to the employee. It is required to be undertaken every 3 years.</p> <p>Hall Caretaker - will keep the hall in a clean condition for its various users and will liaise with the lettings manager to provide a good experience for all hall users. Ability to use standard cleaning equipment and chemicals is required. All equipment and chemicals will be provided. Occasional weekend visits to the hall may be required. It is expected this role will require 4 hours per week / 16 hours per month. £13 per hour. agreements and risk assessments are in place, issue invoices for hall use and ensure hiring fees are paid, liaise with the caretaker for specific hall care needs and report to a nominated line manager regarding hall usage and any issues. The lettings manager will be required to stand in for the caretaker during holidays. Some of the booking and administrative work may be done from home. Occasional weekend visits to the hall may be required. Ability to use and keep at home a laptop is required, also ability to use standard cleaning equipment and chemicals. It is expected this role will require 2 to 3 hours per week / 10 hours per month. £13 per hour. 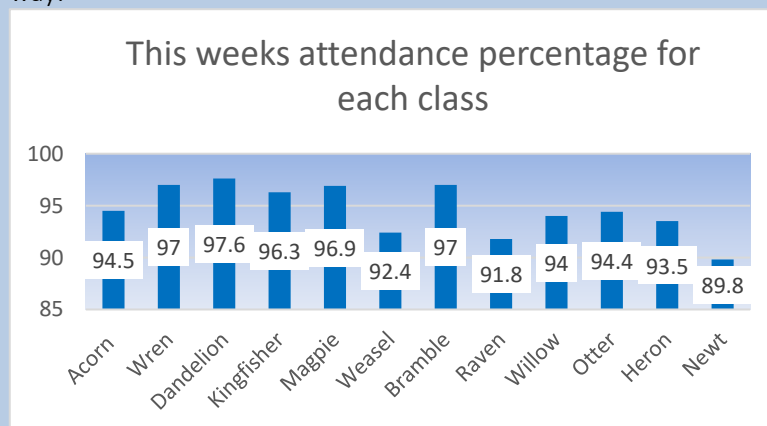

- Feeling embarrassed in front of their friends

- Missing the beginning of vital lessons making them fall behind
- Missing important instructions for the rest of the school day
- Learning bad habits which could affect their employability in the future

The impact of being just a little late can accumulate to a loss in learning time:

Minutes late per day during the school year	Equals days worth of teaching lost in a year
5 mins	3.4 days
10 mins	6.9 days
15 mins	10.3 days
20 mins	13.8 days
30 mins	20.7 days

### Online safety

Whatsapp (16+) Groups chats

Recently, there have been several incidents involving the misuse of WhatsApp groups. We would like to remind parents and children that the minimum age for using WhatsApp is 16 years or older.

WhatsApp is a chat application that can be used on mobile phones or tablets, allowing users to send messages, images, and videos to friends. It supports both one-on-one and group conversations.

We urge all parents to monitor their child's mobile phone and online activities, especially those involving social media. It is essential for children to be aware that they must inform a parent or adult if they receive any inappropriate content from any application.

As a school, we strongly advise the removal of chat groups involving other children. Such groups can lead to issues both in and outside of school.

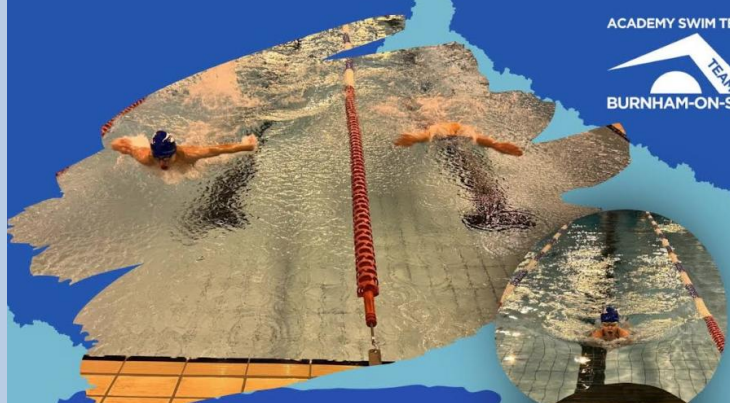

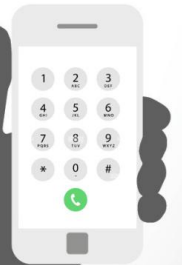
